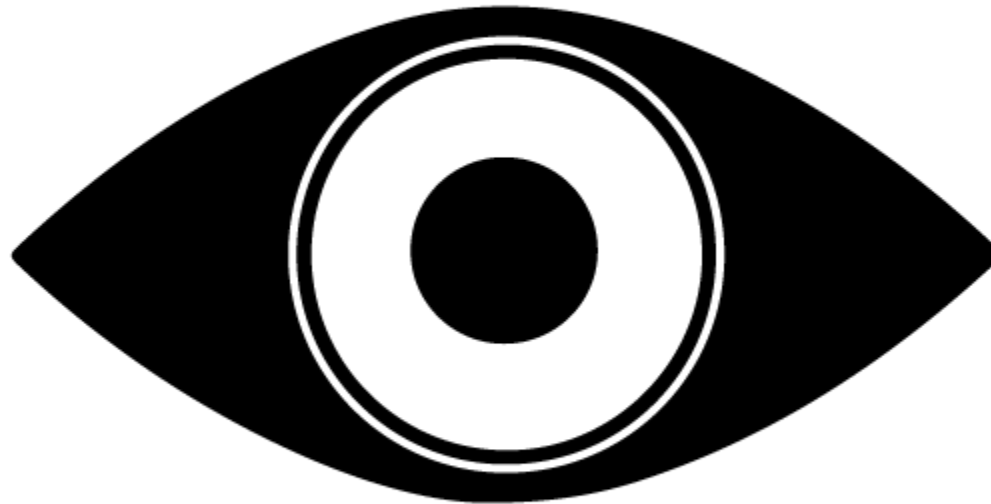




Big Brother Is Watching You
