Me, Myself & I

Choosing the correct pronoun can be difficult when there's someone else in the sentence as well. The easiest way to see if you're using the correct pronoun in these sentences is to remove the other subject/object and see what pronoun is left. We usually put the other person before *I* or *me*. *Myself* can also be used as an intensifier: *I myself don't like grammar*.
