The Cave of Swimmers

Lybia



The Cave of Swimmers is located on the plateau of **Gilf Kebir**, Lybia. Its walls are covered in **Neolithic pictographs** dating back to 10,000 years ago, that is, the **Ice Age**. Hungarian explorer **László Almásy** discovered the cave in 1933 and described it in his book **The Unknown Sahara (1934)**. The cave was made famous by the 1997 film **The English Patient**, which gives a fictionalized account of Almásy's life.
