




Who Invented the Computer?

The principle of the modern computer was first described by British mathematician Alan Turing in 1936. He built on Kurt Gödel's 1931 results on the limits of proof and computation, replacing Gödel's universal arithmetic-based language with the hypothetical devices that became known as Turing machines.

He proved that such machine would be capable of performing any conceivable mathematical computation, provided that it was represented as an algorithm. In 1941 German engineer Konrad Zuse created the Z3, the first automatic, digital computer. In 1946 the first American-made computer, known as ENIAC, was first utilized for military purposes. Since then, this device hasn't ceased to be perfected and exported worldwide.
