Ball's Pyramid Australia



The tallest **volcanic stack** in the World measures **562** meters in height, 1,100 meters in length and 300 meters across.

This gigantic and isolated **skerry** is part of the **Lord Howe Island Marine Park** in Australia and was discovered in **1788** by **Lieutenant Henry Lidgbird Ball** – hence its name.

The first climbers to make it to its top were Bryden Allen, John Davis, Jack Pettigrew and David Witham in February **1965**.
