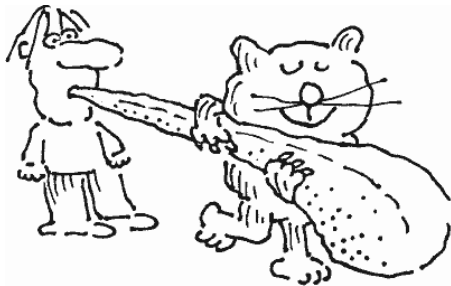




Idiom #31 Cat Idioms



Has a cat got your tongue?



To let the cat out of the bag



To put the cat among the pigeons

'Has a cat got your tongue?' is said to someone when you are annoyed that they won't speak:
Why won't you answer me? Has a cat got your tongue?

If you **'let the cat out of the bag'** you reveal something secret or private, often without meaning to:
He let the cat out of the bag and accidentally told her about her surprise party.

'To put the cat among the pigeons' means to do or say something that will make a lot of people angry or worried:
I don't want to put the cat among the pigeons, but we will have to cancel the holidays of all the employees.
