The firebird, a bird with **glowing** feathers that is both a blessing and a bringer of doom to its owner, stars in a number of Russian tales, including Tsarevitch Ivan, the Firebird and the **Gray Wolf and The Humpbacked Horse**. In the latter tale a little horse helps Ivan, a young peasant, carry out the many unreasonable demands of the tsar. Censors banned the story in the mid-19th century because it made the Tsar appear foolish. The tale is meant to be a satire on the absurdities of Russian feudal and bureaucratic life. The story gained huge popularity in Soviet Russia and was also set to music in 1911 by **Igor Stravinsky**.
