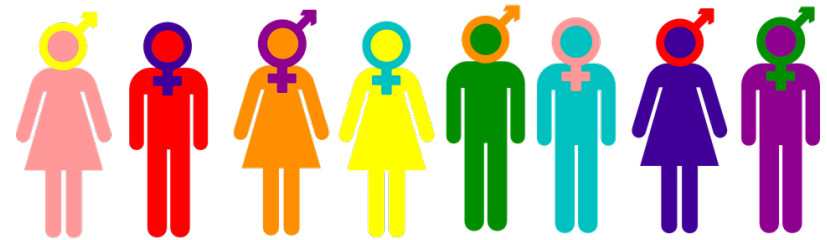


## ENGLISH: AN UNGENDERED LANGUAGE?
