

In the thick of the srilankan jungle, there lies a massive rock totalling 200 meters in height and known as Sigiriya, Lion Rock. Inhabited since prehistoric time, this rock was first turned into a fortress in 495 CE by Kashiapa, one of the King's love children. Later, it was turned into a Buddhist monastery before being deserted. The giant lion's paws carved at the foot of this rock still bear witness to this far-away past while coloring the wilderness of the place with a tinge of nostalgia.
