The Voronet Monastery Romania



The Voronet Monastery (Suceava County), was commissioned by **Stephen the Great** in **1488** to celebrate the victory against the **Ottomans** at **Vaslui**. It is commonly referred to as the **Sistine Chapel of the East** on account of its marvelous frescoes, which feature an intense shade of blue known in Romania as **Voronet blue**.
