The Voronet Monastery (Suceava County), was commissioned by Stephen the Great in 1488 to celebrate the victory against the Ottomans at Vaslui. It is commonly referred to as the Sistine Chapel of the East on account of its marvelous frescoes, which feature an intense shade of blue known in Romania as Voronet blue.
