

Unlike its name may suggest, the red panda is not closely related to the giant panda: as a member of the Ailuridae family, it is related to the weasel, the raccoon and the skunk. It is an arboreal mammal slightly larger than a domestic cat, native to the Himalayas and to Southwestern China. It mainly feeds on bamboo, even though it is omnivorous. It has recently been classified as an endangered species, as its population totals less than 10,000 wild individuals. Its decline is mainly caused by habitat loss (due to the increasing urbanization of forest areas in China) and inbreeding depression.
