I **WILL** love you forever

**WILL** is associated with unpremeditated decisions: it is used when speaking off-the-cuff, that is, without having planned anything.



I **AM GOING TO**  
love you forever

**TO BE GOING TO** conveys an idea of imminence: it means that you have already done some planning and mean to carry it out.



I **AM LOVING**  
you forever

The **PRESENT CONTINUOUS** is attached a future meaning when it expresses something that has already been planned, scheduled and organized: it's as if the action were already in progress.
