## Paro Taktsang Bhutan





This temple complex was built in 1692, and its story is deeply rooted in the introduction of **Buddhism** to the country. The site was chosen due to its closeness to the cave where Guru Padmasambhava meditated for three years, three months, three days and three hours in the 8<sup>th</sup> century. This is only one of thirteen total **taktsang**, that is, 'tiger lair' caves where Padmasambhava is believed to have meditated. The place is also known as the 'tiger's nest', as Padmasambhava is said to have landed here after a flight on the back of a tigress all the way from **Tibet**.

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
