Sir Winston Churchill (1874-1965) served twice as Prime Minister of the United Kingdom(1940-1945, 1951-1955). He also was an officer in the British Army, a historian, and a writer: he was awarded with the Nobel Prize in Literature in 1953 and is thought to have inspired the character of Winston Smith from Nineteen Eighty-Four by George Orwell.
