- **MAKING** someone **do** something means **forcing** this person to do so.
- **LETTING** someone **do** something means giving this person **permission** to do so.
- **GETTING** someone **TO do** something means **convincing** this person to do so.
- **HAVING** someone **do** something ( or having something done by someone) means entrusting a person with a **favor, task** or **professional service**.
