Tibetan Sand Fox

The Tibetan sand fox is endemic to the high **Tibetan Plateau** and Ladakh Plateau in Nepal, China, Sikkim, and Bhutan, up to altitudes of about **5300 m**. These **daytime predators'** staple food is the **pika**, a small mammal inhabiting cold climates [check out the next Pinboard for this animal]. Even though Tibetan sand foxes are mostly **solitary**, they may occasionally form commensal bonds with brown bears after teaming up on hunting pikas. While the bear digs out the pikas from their burrows, the fox grabs them as they are escaping the bear.
