Alice's Adventures in Wonderland is an 1865 novel written by English mathematician Charles Lutwidge Dodgson under the pen name Lewis Carroll. It tells the story of a girl named Alice who, subsequent to falling through a rabbit hole, explores a fantasy world populated by bizarre anthropomorphic creatures. The tale plays with mathematics and logic and is abundant in puns as well as witticisms and conundrums, thus giving the story lasting popularity among adults as well as children. It is considered to be one of the finest examples of the literary nonsense genre and its plot, characters and imagery have been enormously influential in both popular culture and literature.
